

PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT INFORMATION:



Screening of learners takes place from 07:00 – 07:30. Please ensure that your child is at school by 07:30 the latest. Sufficient requests in this regard were sent to parents in 2021. Children arriving late for school will **NOT BE TOLERATED**. Continuous late-coming will be reported to our District Office, and dealt with accordingly. It is very disruptive and unfair to learners who are already in class and busy with work when a child enters the classroom late.

TRAFFIC CONGESTION

Kindly display patience and respect to other road users as well as to our learners. Please refrain from parking in front of residential driveways, entrances to the school, on corners of the road and on pedestrian crossings. Occupy only one parking bay when dropping your child off – drop and drive away to open parking for others. Please adhere to the one-way signs.

PARENTS' CODE OF CONDUCT

Parents are expected to behave in an exemplary and respectful manner towards other parents, teachers and learners when dropping their children off at school and collecting them from school.

HOLIDAYS

Parents must please arrange their holidays in accordance with the school calendar and ensure that their child/children attend school during the allocated term dates. As school attendance is **compulsory by law** for all children between the ages of 7 and 15, no educator or Principal may give permission for pupils to take leave during the terms.

APPOINTMENTS

Parents are reminded that **NO** walk-ins to Reception will be allowed. It is imperative that you phone the school to schedule an appointment should it be necessary for you to enter the school offices. This is in compliance with Covid protocol. Please adhere to this rule.



Due to safety risks parents are requested to refrain from passing lunch etc. over the fence to learners during breaks. Please note that <u>NO PARCELS</u> will be accepted at Reception. This includes, but is not limited to lunches, projects, homework, PT clothes, sports kits, school bags, stationery, tuck money etc. Please ensure that your child has everything he/she needs before being dropped off at school.

The **ONLY EXCEPTION** will be the acceptance of **chronic medication**, eg. Insulin.

SPORT NEWS


We had a very successful Inter-House Athletics Meeting on Tuesday, 18th January 2022.
