2023 APPLICATIONS FOR ENROLMENT

Grade 1 and Grade 8 applications for enrolment for 2023 must be done **ONLINE** again this year. The Department of Education has confirmed that the application period starts on **22 JULY 2022 at 08:00** and will close on **19 AUGUST 2022 at 00:00**. To apply, please visit: www.gdeadmissions.gov.za **Please remember to upload certified copies of your documents within 7 days of applying.** The GDE will send an SMS notification to parents/guardians from 3 – 31 October 2022 to accept or decline the placement.

2023 Grade 00, R and Grade 2-7 applications for **NEW** learners opened on the **9th May 2022**. **Gr. 00 learners must re-apply for Gr. R.** Application forms may be collected from the school during school hours.
