Please treat this as urgent as we have to submit the number of children returning to Summerfields Primary in 2025 to District Office.

- 4. Learners who arrive at school once the bell has rung at 07:40 are recorded for late-coming. This is a directive from the GDE.
- 5. According to the Schools Act, it is the parents' responsibility to ensure that their child arrives at school on time.



NO PARENTS OR VISITORS ARE ALLOWED ON THE SCHOOL PREMISES. IF YOU HAVE AN APPOINTMENT WITH A TEACHER, ATTENDING AN ASSEMBLY, FETCHING A LEARNER OR HAVE ANY QUERIES, REPORT TO RECEPTION VIA THE ENTRANCE TO THE OFFICES IN PIAGGIO STREET TO SIGN IN AT THE SCHOOL.

<u>WAITING AREA</u>: As from 17 July 2024, the waiting area will be locked promptly at 14:30. <u>PARENTS ARE TO ENSURE THAT THEIR CHILD IS FETCHED FROM SCHOOL BY 14:30 THE VERY LATEST</u>. Learners not fetched timeously will be taken to the aftercare facility, and parents will be billed accordingly.

## **DON'T BE LATE**
